

## Guidelines for using an irrigation or non-potable water supply in a Mobile Home or RV Park



If you intend to provide a separate water supply to your residents for irrigation or other uses, e.g. car washing, that does not meet the water supply requirements of Chapter 64E-15.003(1), Florida Administrative Code, the Lee County Health Department, Environmental Health Section recommends following these guidelines to protect the health of your residents:

The preferred method for non-potable water supplies: (and this is the only method allowable for reclaimed water supplies):

- Install the non- potable hose bibb in a below ground box
- Label the box “WATER NOT SAFE FOR DRINKING” In English and any other language that is commonly spoken by the residents.
- If you are using a reclaimed water supply, all boxes and pipes must be painted purple.

As an alternative:

- Paint all non-potable water pipes and bibbs with bright red paint
- Label the standing hose bibb “WATER NOT SAFE FOR DRINKING” In English and any other language that is commonly spoken by the residents.
