3 boys who played with rabid bat on Fort Myers Beach still not found

The Lee County Health Department is still looking for three boys that came into contact with a rabid bat at Fort Myers Beach on June 15.

Health department officials are searching for the boys so that they can begin a series of rabies vaccinations.

Rabies is a fatal disease, and the boys, if they were infected, need to start the rabies shots within 10 days, according to health officials.

The health department is looking for help from the public in locating the boys.
