FGCU confirms first swine flu case

FGCU has confirmed a case of swine flu on campus.

Provost Ronald Toll announced Thursday that the student in question already has been treated, and in an abundance of caution, treatment was provided to the student's roommates.

Florida Gulf Coast University has notified the Lee County Health Department, and the university's student health services department is prepared to work with students and respond to health needs. If students develop flu-like symptoms — such as a fever, cough or sore throat — they are asked to call health services at 590-7966. Faculty and staff exhibiting these symptoms should contact their health care provider.

Lee County recorded its first swine flu death this week, and has confirmed 43 cases since the outbreak this spring.
