

## **Immunizations outreach changes hours**

**Aug. 19, 2011**

**Fort Myers, FL—** The Lee County Health Department is extending its immunization hours by 30 minutes each day and limiting its evening outreach hours to once a month from September through December 2011 to allow for employee training.

The evening outreach program, known as “Shots for Tots,” will continue to see the first 25 clients and more if time permits, during the once-monthly clinics located in Bonita, Lehigh Acres and North Fort Myers. The daytime hours at the 3920 Michigan Avenue, Fort Myers location, beginning September 1, 2011, will be 8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday and 1 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. Friday.

Beginning September 1, 2011, the immunization “Shots for Tots” schedule will be:

These changes reflect a decrease from two clinics per month to one at the Lehigh and Pondella locations. The second clinics at Lehigh and Pondella will resume in January 2012.
